RED III Germany

The German cabinet on 10 December approved legislation to implement the EU's Renewable Energy Directive (RED III) into national law. The end of double counting for advanced biofuels removes a key point of market uncertainty.
The new law is still not in force and market is very nervous.

New Nabisy rules for on site audits - be ready for January 2027

To obtain access rights for the Federal Office for Agriculture and Food as the competent authority under the RED for a given state, the consent to MS audits of the respective state is required.
Consequences:
if your country will be not listed on Nabisy list -> the fuel cannot be considered for the quota if brought into the market after 1st January 2027
